- 1997 (Winnipeg), National Profile, National Examination, National Registry
- 3. 2001 National Occupational Competency Profile
- 4. 2011 revised National Occupational Competency Profile

History

- Paramedic Association of Canada is the holder of the NOCP
- 2. Canadian Medical Association provides medical education program accreditation
- 3. The rules governing education are provincial
- 4. Public and private educational institutions compete for students
- 5. Paramedics are independent practitioners and oversight is 'weak' by design
