Historical perspective

- 1997: Development of the National Occupational Competency Profile (NOCP) – Federal Government funded
- 2001: Approval by the Board of the Paramedic Association of Canada, acceptance by the Canadian Medical Association for the purpose of accreditation of educational programs
- 2011: Revised NOCP, inclusion of *Health Promotion* and *Public Safety* (recognition of non-urgent care and contribution)
- 2015: New Canadian Paramedic Profile
